How to obtain the required lab tests for your Form I-693

- Don't do the tests until you have visited your civil surgeon. He needs to check your identification, then enter the test orders
- LabCorp is the primary source used for lab tests. Your civil surgeon will send orders to LabCorp electronically, and results will be sent electronically to him as soon as they are complete. The orders are valid at any LabCorp site nation-wide
- You may schedule an appointment to have your blood drawn on the day of your I-693 examination. Schedule enough time to finish the exam and travel to the lab site (generally at least 2 hours after your appointment starts.) Schedule your appointment at <https://www.labcorp.com/labs-and-appointments/>
You may also go without an appointment.
- Dr. Nelson has a contract with LabCorp that allows you to receive a significant discount. The discount will be applied when he pays for the tests
- Tests are paid for in advance. Do not pay when you go for the lab tests
- Fasting is not required. Drink plenty of water before your blood is drawn
- Tuberculosis tests usually take the longest to return. The average time is 4-7 days
